A new planning application has been submitted for the bottom of South Street. This application is for up to 50 residential dwellings. The reference number for the new application is WD/2020/1848/MAO

It remains so important that people let Wealden District Council and the Planning Inspector know their views. Village Concerns are reviewing the application and will be providing guidance for commenting in due course.

Because this is a NEW application none of the previous objections will be carried forwards and you need to object again.

The closing date for objections is December 25th.

The Parish Council are holding a planning meeting to discuss this application on Wednesday 25th November at 7pm. Anyone wishing to participate in this meeting virtually needs to contact the Clerk at least 24 hours before the meeting - 07948 496760 or easthoathlywithhallandpc@gmail.com

This is now the third application for this site. [The initial intention of the developer was to build 140 homes on South Street.] The very first application was for 74 houses. This was refused by Wealden District Council and a subsequent appeal to the Planning Inspectorate was lost. The second application for 55 houses was turned down by Wealden District Council this summer and is currently being appealed by the applicant. The consultation for this appeal with the Planning Inspector ends on December 2nd and there is still time to comment:
