On another note, Village Concerns approached Wealden District Council's, CEO to drop their continued fight against us in the Judicial Review and sent them a letter about this. A short extract from our letter: "Village Concerns has now been granted permission for a Judicial Review Hearing on the decision to grant Outline Consent. When Justice Lang granted this permission, she did so on both the grounds of our claim and her wording strongly reflected the strength of our case. Wealden District Council has already spent a considerable amount of public money on their defence of this Judicial Review. We urge you to reconsider the Council's continued defence of this bad decision. Do not waste any more public money on this matter."
