The Foresters Arms in East Hoathly has been successfully listed by Historic England on January 26th of this year.

Unfortunately, days before and after the Listing, some work began at the Foresters and Village Concerns had to inform WDC to get a stop to the work (which has happened) as the correct procedures were not followed for Listed Building works. We hope that very little damage was done.

Village Concerns also emailed Wealden's Planning Committee South, the Listing link and also encouraged them to read it - it was at the Hearing for the Foresters Arms Planning Application that the Wealden Planning Officer said he did not expect the Foresters to be listed, in part based on Wealden's own Conservation Officer's opinion.
