We notified you in Update 57 of an Amendment to the Hesmonds Planning Application. Village Concerns has checked with the Wealden Planning Department and been given confirmation that all original objections for the Hesmonds Hybrid Application and subsequent objections regarding the London Road Access Amendment still stand and you do not need to make a new objection.

However to show our continuing opposition to this application, if you have objected before, can you please reaffirm your objection(s) .

Our suggested wording:

"My original objection(s) to this application for 205 houses being built in East Hoathly still stands. In addition this application contravenes the Submission Local Plan for Wealden.

If you have not objected before please contact us if you need further assistance.

Village Concerns will also be submitting an objection in the strongest terms.

The removal of the Ailies Lane element from the Hesmonds Application does not remove the potential blight on this community of 205 unwanted homes in East Hoathly. Clearly Hesmonds are not giving up on their plans despite Wealden's Submission Local Plan making it clear that such development in East Hoathly would not be accepted. We must remain vigilant as the developers evidently still feel that they can succeed.

Thank you for your time, your effort and your continuing support. We must continue fighting.
