WD/2016/2268/F is about the erection of 2 houses on land at the top of Buttsfield Lane. This Hesmond Stud application is based on vehicle access from Buttsfield Lane, i.e. tarmac extension of an unadopted lane over the Wealdway footpath, requiring destruction of hedgerow and trees in order to get width for vehicles and construction traffic.

If the development goes ahead then:

**all vehicle access should be from the existing stud access road; not across a public footpath.**

Just imagine construction traffic using Buttsfield Lane! and what right has a Hesmond Stud development got to extend an unadopted road over our public footpath?
